TRAINING PACKAGES

Concord Equestrian Center training programs are tailored to each individual rider and horse. Our package prices are based on the number of "services" the Concord staff provide to you and your horse during the week. Services include any of the following: lessons, lungeing, turnout, or schooling session. We will create a program for you and your horse based on the number of services necessary to achieve the goals you desire.

FULL & HALF TRAINING

You may choose to either work with Mark Conley, our head trainer or with one of our assistant trainers. Our assistant trainers work under the close supervision of Mark with students that aspire to show at the County and A level Show Circuit.

Full Training Package w/Head Trainer (six services/week)	- \$600
Special Training -Pony (3+ services a week as needed)	- \$375
1/2 Training Package (three services/week)	- \$350
Beginning show training(two lessons + 1 show/month)	- TBD per horse

Services can include lessons, lungeing, turn-outs, or a trainer schooling the horse. If the horse is ridden 3 times a week or more by a trainer, the horse will also need to be in full grooming.

SPECIAL TRAINING - \$775.00 a month:

This package is intended for those with a young horse they wish to have started under saddle or over fences and also for horses in need of special re-training. Emphasis is placed on physical conditioning to ensure long-term soundness, with appropriate gradual development of flat work and jumping skills utilizing riding, lunging and long lining to achieve desired results.

FULL GROOMING - \$275.00 a month.

This fee covers the grooming of your horse including tacking up and un-tacking of your horse six days a week. Any horse ridden by a trainer more than three days a week will be required to be under full training.

BOARDING FEES

Concord Equestrian Center (CEC) is located on the property of Del Mar Horsepark. The board prices are fixed by the State of California 22nd District Department of Agriculture. All stalls have automatic waters. Included in all boarding fees is general maintenance of the grounds, cleaning of the stalls as well as hay feeding both morning and night. All other services are provided by Concord Equestrian Center.

BOX STALLS - \$670/mo.

The box stalls are located in the main stall rows. They are 12X12 with chest high front walls through which the horses may look out. In addition to the above mentioned services the Horsepark also provides bedding (shavings) for the box stalls.

PIPE STALLS - \$500/mo.

The pipe stalls are located on the west side of the property. They are spacious 15 X 24 open stalls with a roof overhanging one half of the stall enclosure. For an additional fee CEC will line the stalls with plywood walls to further protect your horse. CEC takes responsibility for bedding the stalls 2x a week for a fee of \$65/month.

LUNCH PROGRAM - \$115/mo.

CEC uses high-quality feeds in combination with flax seed oil, olive oil, salt and a full spectrum vitamin supplement produced by Scifeed. Your horse's feed program will be reviewed on a regular basis to ensure that optimum weight and health is achieved while keeping your horses attitude calm. Upon the recommendation of a veterinarian other supplements may also be fed for an additional fee.

FARRIER SERVICE - \$35-\$200/service (every six to eight weeks)

Our regular farrier services are provided by Francisco Ortizaro. Special corrective shoeing will incur an additional charge.

WORMING, VACCINATIONS AND MEDICATIONS

CEC has a regular worming and vaccination program. Worming is done every six to eight weeks and vaccinations are given in the spring and the fall. You will notice the appropriate charges on your bill.

Also, if it is required that your horse be administered a medication regularly upon recommendation of a veterinarian you will be billed accordingly.

LEASE PACKAGE INFORMATION AND FEES

1/2 LEASE PROGRAM: The responsibilities of half leasing include;

A) Half of all the horse's expenses per month.

B) The owner of the horse charges a lease fee that helps subsidize the original purchase price and to cover the devaluation of the horse due to age and use. Typically no less than \$200/month and can easily reach up to \$700+/month.

C) All half leases must be in half training with Concord Equestrian Center. Half training (\$350-\$375) includes three services a week, with lessons being considered a type of service (other services include training ride by instructor, lunging, and turn out, and may be substituted for a lesson in the absence of the leasee). (Compared to the 3 day a week school lesson price of \$660 per month half training is a 42% discount for providing your own horse and is our way of encouraging progress for the student.)

FIRST TIME SHOW LEASE PROGRAMS are offered on our school horses at a flat rate:

Program 1: Includes 2 lessons/week and 1 show/month up to 6 per year - \$750***

Program 2: Includes 2 lessons/week and 2 shows/month up to 12 per year - \$850***

***these are offered on a limited basis at the instructors discretion. They are meant for riders who wish to ride the same horse or pony every lesson and would like to try showing for the first time. SHOW COACHING AND ENTRY FEES are NOT included in this price
